School Payments

Please note that **BPoint** payment is the preferred form of payment.



For all excursions and in-house activities organised by the school two forms will be sent home to families whose child is involved with the activity - an **Excursion Permission Form** and a **Tax Invoice**.

- The **Excursion Permission Form** must be completed, signed and returned to the teacher,
- The **Tax Invoice** for the activity must be paid by the due date. At the foot of the Tax Invoice are the various payment methods.

QParents

QParents is a secure, online portal that has been created by the Department of Education and Training to provide parents of Queensland state school students with twenty-four hour access to their child's information.

The portal allows you to securely access information about your child and communicate directly with your child's school.

Absence from school

If your child will be absent you are required to advise the school. A dedicated Absentee Line **07 3421 0360** should be called by 9:00am stating the child's name, class and reason for absence. Once the roll has been marked an SMS will be generated and sent to all parents/carers where there is an Unexplained Absence. You can either reply to the SMS or call the office to explain the absence. Unexplained Absences will be recorded on Report Cards.

Late Arrival/Early Departure from School

Students who arrive to school late or are picked up early must be signed in/out at the Office. A '*Late Arrival/Early Departure*' slip will be issued for the student.
